## **ANNUAL REPORT 2023-24**

At the onset, let me brief you about the inception of our school.

- This institution was started as the first English Medium School in 1952. And later
  in 1961, Lions club took over the management. The new premises was laid by
  Hisexcellency Sri V VGiri, the then Governor of Kerala, who later became the
  President of India. The school has grown into a full fledged institution falling in
  line with the CBSE since 1997.
- In 1998, thePalghat Lions School was affiliated to CBSE.
- It is our 26<sup>th</sup> Annual Day from the time of the school's affiliation.
- Being in the field education formore than 70years, Palghat Lions School is forging aheadtowards excellence in education.
- I am indeed honoured to have this opportunity to present before you the consistent upward graph of our school achievements.
- The first being, Consumer Protection Excellence Award bestowed on us for beingTHE BEST SCHOOLby RTI Council in 2022-23.

We are fortunate to have a committed and supportive management who have implemented many new programmes in the academic year 2022-23 and 2023-24.

- Renovations in the building were made in the primary block with prefabricated façade and roof elements giving us a well protected terrace which has been a venue for several activities.
- ➤ The school garden was cordoned off with screen mesh and a small herbal garden was put in place to create awareness among students about medicinal properties of these plants.

- ➤ Partial iron railings were constructed in the ground floor corridor of the Primary block as a safety measure.
- ➤ Construction of Fire Exit was a boon for us, as it is a connection between the primary and science block and a time saver.
- Keeping in mind the increase in the number of students and change in the school timings, new washrooms were constructed in the science block
- ➤ The Senior computer lab was upgraded with laptops, while the junior computer lab was equipped with new desktops.
- ➤ Lions Quest, an initiative of the Lions Club conducted a session for about 30 teachers on Skills for Adolescence and these skills are being imparted to students of Std 6, 7 and 8 preparing them for the 21<sup>st</sup> century skills and their future life.

- ➤ IN THE YEAR 2019 WE HAD BHAVANA N SIVADAS WHO SECURED 1<sup>ST</sup> RANKIN THE GENERAL CATEGORY AT THE ALL INDIA LEVEL AISSE

HAVING produced 3 National topperswecontinue the legacy of our school and are proud to report that we have maintained 100% pass results in the previousyears in SSE and SSCE. And we hope to continue the same in the years to come.

We introduced the Humanities Stream in the academic year 2022-23 with a variety of subjects.

➤ 131 students registered, 10 students- full A1, 33 students above 90% and 117 students above 75%.

#### > In SSE

- ➤ 154 students registered, 6 students full A1, 24 students above 90%, 108 students above 75%.
- ➤ It is very important to note that the students of this batch studied in the online mode during the lock-down period and a lot of effort was put in by teachers to prepare them for the Board examinations and the results were really appreciable.

#### PTA PROJECTS

We have a strong Parent Teacher association handholding and guiding us always.

- ➤ The school convenes a General Body Meeting at the beginning of the Academic Year where the PTA acknowledges and honours the 10<sup>th</sup> & 12<sup>th</sup> toppers.
- ➤ There has always been a practice of giving out Festival allowance to the nonteaching staff which happened this year also.
- ➤ PTA also arranged an Orientation session for Students of Std 9 "Unleash the power within you in your teens" conducted by Mrs. Vijitha, a professional counsellor.
- ➤ The Hindu-Young India NEWSPAPER has been subscribed for all classes from 3 to 12 by the PTA because they strongly believe in inculcating the habit of reading.
- ➤ And of course their star venture this year, is the procurement of brand new set of BAND instruments worth Rs. 3.8 lakhs which was a great motivation for this institution.

### PREFECTORIAL BOARD

➤ The prefectorial Board is a vibrant and active team of students who are well-disciplined and follow the code of conduct. They strive well reminding the other students of their conduct and behavior and assist us in maintaining the discipline of this school.

I am blessed to have selfless, devoted educators who encourage and give personalized attention to foster, flourish and develop the students' skills.

The school gives a platform to students to project their talents.

TALENT FESTis conducted every year with an objective of providing equal opportunities to students to showcase their inborn talents.

➤ This was followed by District Sahodaya Kalolsavwhich saw participation of 155 students, Securing 29 prizes, 30 A grades, 16 B grades and 14 C grades and we were Overall 5<sup>th</sup> position out of 64 schools.

- ➤ This led to the State Sahodaya Kalotsav where again 36 students participated securing 3 prizes and Our school was 4<sup>th</sup> position in Palakkad Sahodaya.
- ➤ A very interesting event English Fest conducted by Palakkad District Sahodaya Complex ESPERANTO 2K23 again saw participation of 63 students where we were :-
- ➤ Overall 1<sup>st</sup> runner-up inCategory II.
- ➤ Secured2<sup>nd</sup> position in "Pros and Cons" Category III and "Live Reporting" Category IV.
- > And secured 3<sup>rd</sup> position in "Be the character"-Category 1

We also know that Athletic prowess and academics always go hand in hand and Sports is a very important part of education, as they aid in the overall personality development of a student. We are fortunate to have a team of Physical Education teachers, 4 in number, who work relentlessly to bring out the best talents in the field of sports.

The school ANNUAL SPORTS DAY was conducted in December 2023. Various programmes were displayed by the students. Their team spirit and enthusiasm was much evident.

**Palghat Lions School** has participated in CBSE Cluster Athletics securing 1<sup>st</sup> in 200 m and 2<sup>nd</sup> in 100 m and this was awarded to Anvie.Sof Std 6 who qualified for the CBSE National Athletic meet at Chattisgarh.

- ➤ In the CBSE Cluster X Kho-kho championshipwe secured 3<sup>rd</sup> position in U-19 Category Boys.
- ➤ We also participated in the CBSE Cluster X Kabbadi-and secured4<sup>th</sup> position in U-19 Category Boys.

- ▶ Palakkad District SahodayaKho-kho Championship saw us securing the 2<sup>nd</sup> position in U-19 Category (boys) out of 24 schools.
- ➤ In Palakkad District SahodayaAthletic Meetwe won 8 gold; 6 silver; 3 bronze and we secured 4<sup>th</sup> position out of 40 schools and Individual Champions were awarded to— Anvie Sand Sujith H.
- ➤ Participation in Palakkad District Sahodaya Chess Tournament"CAISSA"-saw us securing 1<sup>st</sup> position in Category 1 and 4 (girls) and 2<sup>nd</sup> position in Category 3(girls). The girls having an upper hand over the boys.
- > M Navaneeth of class XII qualified for CBSE National Archery Championship.
- Our school was also awarded 2<sup>nd</sup> position for the poster making Anti-drug campaign "VIMUKTHI" conducted by Excise Dept. of Palakkad.

A chanceto learn new skills and better practices helps one to improve, develop and succeed.

- ➤ A series of workshops and training programmeswere attended by teachers for their professional development- conducted by CBSE.
- ➤ We have an ongoing training programme for teachers with CLLE (Centre for Learning Leadership and Excellence) arranged by our School management to guide us to improve our pedagogy, teaching learning styles and to be more child centered.
- ➤ **The school assists**students to cultivate a sense of unity, teamwork, empathy, care & share.
- ➤ We have 4 houses- Ruby, Emerald, Sapphire and Topaz under the efficient House Captains and various clubs such as Eco, Math, Literary, Road Safety, Music, Health, Social Service to name a few where multi faceted activities are carried out.

- ➤ We are proud to have one unit of Scouts and two units of Guides in our institution and this helps the future generation to develop a set of moral values and discipline.
  - ❖ 4 of our student girl guides got selected for RajyaPuraskar Test Camp.
- A plethora of events were conducted in the year 2021-22 and 22-23 in our school.
- ➤ Our school hosted SAHODAYA MERIT DAY conducted by PDSSC forhonouring the SSE and SSCE Toppers of the District for the year 22-23 and 23-24.
- Celebration ofimportant days such as world Environment day, Hiroshima Day, World Refugee Day to name a few and festivals are a part of our school activity, so that the students learn a bit of our customs, culture and heritage.
- ➤ A very interesting initiative by the Kerala Government TheYoung Innovative Programme (YIP) aiming to empower the future innovators has been initiated in our institution to identify the emerging creators.
- ➤ In YIP Star Challenge 2023, we had 259 pre- registrations, 174 ideator registration and 20 teams out of which 10 teams have already registered their ideas.

- ➤ The School Magazine is the pulse of an institution and thelps in providing an outlet for students' creativity. Our school magazine -MUSINGS, showcasing the record of events and activities was released last year(2022-23) and was Inaugurated by the immediate past President, Ln P M KadijaRahamadulla.
- > "SCIFARI 2K23," the School Science Exhibition was held in our institution from Std 1 to Std 12 to explore many creative talents of our students and to guide

them to think out of the box. More than 250 students participated with still and working models and Innovative ideas were presented leading the children from the realms of theory into the arena of practicum. We hope to conduct this every year.

**We consider** the efforts towards integrating value education in the present system and moving towards the holistic value-based development as worthy for the well being of all. Afew social activities were organized, where our students learn human values like charity, compassion, love and respect through constructive ideas.

- ➤ NALLAPADAM is a social initiative project by MalayalaManorama, which has motivated our students to donate a sapling for the school "With a friend campaign" as Part of the World Environment Day.
- Onam kit was provided for the members of Haritha Karma Sena.
- > Funds were raised for helping a kidney patient for Dialysis and a cancer patient for his treatment.
- ➤ Members students of Social Service Club donated books to students of Govt. Higher Secondary School, Kumarapuram and necessary items for the inmates of Girls metric Hostel.
- > Reading month and Library Week is celebrated in the month of July every year.
- ➤ A well organized book fair was inaugurated by Mr. Mithun Roy, Sub Judge, District Legal Service Authority exposing the students to a world of books.
- > An interactive session with Dr P R Jayaseelan, well known poet and writer was conducted
- Literary Club conducted a Book review contest for the students where Participants showcased their literary insights, critically analyzing a diverse range of books.

- Besides this a diverse range of activities were conducted, like, cover page designing, quiz competition, storytelling competition and donate a book campaign.
- International Yoga and Music Daywas celebrated with great enthusiasm and excitement where about 400students performed Surya NamaskaraYagnam from 6am to 6pm.
- ➤ Science and technology has advanced so much that it has paved a way for development in the field of ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE and ROBOTICS(AIR) and this too has been initiated in our school by specially trained faculty from Amrita University, Coimbatore.
- Another motivating project, SEWA (Social Empowerment through work education) initiated by CBSE, aiming to develop each learners' social, emotional and intellectual growth is a part of the school curriculum. In the academic year 2022-23, PLS conducted many projects for classes 6-10 involving Inter-disciplinary and multi-disciplinary projects, demonstration of yogasanasand understanding the importance of basic medical care(first aid), in case of an emergency.
- ➤ All Classes from KG-Std12 were taken for age appropriate field trips and tours and it was a great enjoyment for the students.
  - > Several awareness Sessionswere organized for students in this academic year such as:-
  - MENSTRUAL HYGIENE for secondary school girls by doctors.
  - A Session by KSEB Officials on "SAVE ELECTRICITY"

- An Awareness session on Drug Abuse and its harmful effects by Mr. Abdul Basith, Excise Official.
- An awareness class on Rabies and its treatment was given for students by Dr. DilipFalgunan, Veterinary Surgeon

We also organized an event for Grandparents on World Elderly Day. It was a heartwarming moment with wonderful cultural show by the students and the grandparents were very happy to be honoured and acknowledged.

- ➤ Medicinal plants were distributed by Eco-club & OISCA which has found its way into our herbal garden.
- ➤ Children from the special school- Chaithanya and Devashrayam performed a veryzestful and exuberant programmes on Independence Day this year and they were acknowledged by the management and the students of this institution.
- ➤ Health check up was conducted for the students to diagnose their fitness with emphasis on eye and dental check-up. Parents were informed of any deviation from the normal.
- ➤ About 30 doctors assisted in diagnosing the students' dental problems.
- > The practice of giving out endowment prizes to support brilliant students has been going on for the past several years and these prizes are usually given out during republic day celebrations.
- > **Students from** Std 1 to Std 10 were exposed to the concept of Bagless Day. Several age appropriate activities were given to them and the students were engaged throughout.
- ❖ Movie, School visit, spell bee, Multi Disciplinary Project, Art Integrated project were some of the activities in which the students were involved.
- Mr. Sundaram Ganesh conducted a motivational class on bagless day for students of Std 5, 6 7.

### **ACCOMPLISHMENTS IN EXTRA CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES**

Our students have performed quite well in the extracurricular activities too with a few students qualifyingin the SIP ARITHMETIC GENIUS National Level and the school secured the position of 1<sup>st</sup> runner up

- ➤ We also won 2 silver and 1 bronze in the Chess Tournament held at P K DAS Institution.
- Navaneeth Krishna of Std 9 was selected for the National Level Kalaripayattu championship.
- ➤ For past two years, we have been taking collective steps towards our vision of incorporating the principles and guidelines as per NEP, and yet we have a long way to go, to make it achievable.
